- 1) Paul was weighing boxes for moving. The first was 12 pounds, the second was 4 pounds and the last was 2 pounds. What is the combined weight of all three boxes?
- 2) A gas station sold 10 boxes of chocolate candy, 3 boxes of sugar candy and 7 boxes of gum. What is the total number of boxes they sold?
- 3) At the arcade Tiffany spent 9 tickets on a hat, 4 on a stuffed animal and 3 on a yoyo. How many tickets did she spend total?
- 4) Janet had 2 dollars. If she got 14 more dollars for doing chores and 3 more for her birthday, how much money does she have now?
- 5) Victor used 11 batteries on his flashlights, 6 in his toys and 3 in his controllers. How many batteries did Victor use?
- 6) Lana recycled 13 cans. Her mom recycled 3 and her sister recycled 2. How many cans did they recycle total?
- 7) A pet store had 4 dogs. On Sunday they got 11 more. On Monday they got 2 more. How many dogs does the pet store have now?
- 8) Luke had 3 new crayons, 6 used crayons and 2 broken crayons. How many crayons did Luke have total?
- 9) Frank read 2 books in May, 16 in June and 2 in July. How many books did Frank read?
- 10) On Monday Gwen jogged 9 kilometers. On Tuesday she jogged 7 kilometers and on Wednesday she jogged 3. How many kilometers did she jog total?
