- 2) There are twenty-three plates in a box. If a restaurant bought seventy-four boxes, how many plates would they have total?
- 3) An orchard owner was counting the number of apples he had total. Each of his thirty-three trees had twenty-seven apples in it. How many apples did he have total?
- 4) Kaleb was packing up his old toys. He managed to squeeze ninety-eight toys into a box. If Kaleb filled up sixty-eight boxes, how many toys did he pack total?
- 5) A teacher had twenty-five students in her classes. If each student completed seventy-eight problems, how many problems would she have to grade?
- 6) A laundry mat owner washed twenty-three loads of towels with eighty-one towels in each load. How many towels did he wash total?
- 7) Rachel was practicing drawing super heroes. Each day she drew forty pictures. How many pictures would she have drawn after seventy-three days?
- 8) There were eighty-three people in line waiting for concert tickets. If each of the tickets costs sixty-seven dollars, how much money would be spent?
- 9) A movie theater has sixty rows of seats. If each row has thirty-two seats in it, how many seats does the theater have total?
- 10) A pizza store sold forty-two pizzas each hour. How many pizzas would they have sold after forty-four hours?
- 11) Isabel had fifty-six shelves of DVDs. If each shelf had ninety-nine movies on it, how many movies did she have total?
- 12) A delivery driver made exactly eighteen stops each day. After eighty-eight days, how many stops would he have made total?
